Thank you for taking the time to learn about TheRide's Service Recovery Proposal.

First and most important, we hope you and yours are safe and supported during these uncertain times.

TheRide has been constantly adjusting to the changing realities of COVID-19 to ensure the continuity and safety of our essential services.

Last year at this time, we adjusted our service to focus on essential travel along key corridors and to essential destinations. Since then, we have taken a cautious and measured approach to add back more service while continuing to prioritize the safety of our riders and staff.

We are hopeful that the availability of vaccines will allow our businesses and schools to fully open soon, and that we can return to enjoying all this community has to offer.

We are preparing to restore our service levels. Our proposed recovery plan includes recommendations to adjust all routes and services. We encourage you to provide your comments during the public engagement period. The final recovery plan will be introduced at public meetings in June and implemented at the end of August 2021.

In this presentation, we will walk through the proposed recovery plan.



Trips available in the City of Ann Arbor and Ypsilanti between Clark Road/East Huron River Drive on the north and Ellsworth Road/Michigan Avenue on the south.

Curb-to-curb service during late-night hours and on major holidays when regular fixed-route service is not available to be provided by FlexRide.

Service is provided in accessible vehicles.

Maintain current service allowing trips to begin and end anywhere within the same designated service area at the same fare.





General Operating Hours

A-Ride (ADA) service is available during TheRide's regularly scheduled fixed route bus service. All A-Ride trips must be completed by the end of these scheduled service hours. If published scheduled fixed route times change, the A-Ride times will change as well.

While Will-Calls can be activated same day, a customer must request a Will-Call return trip in advance when scheduling their initial trip.

Will-Call return trips can be requested for travel from medical appointments, health and human services, Secretary of State and Social Security Administration only.

Base Service Area

The A-Ride Base Service Area is defined by a 3/4 mile radius either side of TheRide's scheduled fixed route bus service. Advance reserved trips, that begin and end within the Base Service Area, are considered ADA trips. Whenever the scheduled fixed route bus service area changes, the A-Ride Base Service Area changes as well.



Persons ages 65 years of age or older are eligible to apply for and receive a GoldRide identification card.

GoldRide Demand Response service to be discontinued. Individuals with disabilities or substantially limited from riding regular fixed-routes are encouraged to apply for A-Ride ADA services.

All GoldRide cardholders can travel for free on TheRide's fixed-route service.



AirRide service tentatively set to resume late spring 2021.



Service between the Blake Transit Center and Detroit to be determined by the Regional Transportation Authority of Southeast Michigan.
