All citizens are advised that the Ann Arbor Area Transportation Authority (AAATA) has prepared a proposed application for State of Michigan financial assistance for fiscal year 2024 as required under Act 51 of the Public Acts of 1951, as amended, and for federal assistance as required under the federal transit laws, as amended.
