

1. When do the service changes go into effect?

- a. TheRide's Fall service changes begin Sunday, August 23, 2026.

2. What are the service changes?

- a. **Route 3: Huron River**
 - i. Routing near Trinity Hospital will be moved from Elliot Dr. to McAuley Dr. to serve the new Alpha House Center on McAuley Dr.
- b. **Route 4: Washtenaw - Local**
 - i. Seasonal changes to restore Fall/Winter schedule.
- c. **Route 25: Ann Arbor - Saline Rd.**
 - i. Multiple weekday and weekend timepoints will be adjusted.
- d. **Route 27: W. Stadium - Oak Valley**
 - i. Multiple weekday and weekend timepoints will be adjusted
 - ii. Weekday and weekend Fifth Ave. & E. Washington St. departure times will be adjusted to :15/:45 past the hour.
- e. **Route 32: Miller - Maple**
 - i. Multiple weekday and weekend timepoints will be adjusted.
- f. **Route 62: U-M - State**
 - i. Seasonal changes to restore Fall/Winter schedule.
 - ii. Southbound route direction will be renamed to: "to State & Eisenhower/State St Park & Ride".
 - iii. Wolverine Tower timepoint will be renamed to: "State & Eisenhower".
- g. **Route 66: Carpenter - Huron Pkwy**
 - i. Seasonal changes to restore Fall/Winter schedule and restore extra trips to Huron High School.

3. Why are some routes changing schedules?

- a. Starting August 23, minor adjustments are being made to multiple routes to improve on-time performance and restore Fall/Winter schedules with schools back in session.

4. Why are some routes restoring their Fall/Winter schedules?

- a. When local schools and colleges return from summer break, routes that primarily serve students return to their regular frequencies in response to higher ridership. In the summer, those routes have reduced service to accommodate lower ridership.

5. Why are many routes getting timepoint adjustments?

- a. Timepoint adjustments are being made to improve on-time performance and the rider's experience.

- 6. Why is Route 62's southbound route direction and Wolverine Tower timepoint being renamed?**
 - a. Wolverine Tower is now closed, and TheRide no longer pulls into their parking lot for a stop. As TheRide no longer serves Wolverine Tower, the name changes are being made to reflect accordingly.
